Origin: Switzerland

Color: Range from a light brown to a dark brown

Production (annual): 22,026 lbs. Milk

875 lbs. Butterfat (4%)

726 lbs. Protein (3.5%)

Size: Mature Cow — 1,500#

Calf at birth — 80#

1869: The first cows and bull were imported to the U.S.

1880: The Brown Swiss Cattle Breeders' Association of the USA was formed.

Today: Association membership is about 789 adult members & +900 junior members.
